

Kindergarten Readiness Checklist

- Be able to state first and last name.
- Use appropriate 3-finger grasp when using pencil and scissors.
- Know all letters in their first name and write it.
- Know basic colors: red, blue, yellow, green, orange, purple, black, white, brown, pink.
- Identify numerals 1-10 in random order.
- Count to 20.
- Use fingers to accurately touch count items to 10.
- Identify most upper and lower case letters.
- Be able to follow 2-3 step directions.
- Be able to rhyme words.
- Be able to retell simple stories in sequence.
- Use restroom and wash hands independently.
- Sit for a story for 10 minutes.
- Clean up after themselves.
- Shares materials and toys with other children.
- Be confident and ready to separate from parent.
- Know concepts of reading such as front to back, flow of book, which page come first and left to right.
- Recognize and name basic shapes: square, circle, triangle, and rectangle.
